- Oversee tank modification and warranty claims
- Visit depots and customers as required
- Manages and maintains owned material to standard that meets optimum quality and safety requirements, set by the Management
- Coordinates high value damage repairs and to assure that timely repairs and maintenance are performed in compliance with the procedures set by NewPort. Reduce the depot-through time

Improvement

- Proactively respond and report improvement opportunities to management.
- Implement improvements in business process, guidelines, and procedures.

Technical maintenance of new and existing material

- Identify technical developments and problems.
- Provide technical support on incidents.
- Make an inventory of equipment repair, control, modify and coordinate repairs and input of all relevant information into the NewPort Computer System.
- Ensure tank containers are maintained to the agreed quality specifications.
- React, alert and take actions on flaws and failures.
- Monitor and control the technical work and functions of the depots.
- Provide input for investment requests.
- Monitor the safety and cleanliness of equipment and take actions for any safety issue.

Manage Depots

- Manage outsourced depots, falling under NewPort's responsibility.
- Instruct and monitor assignments for repairs.
- Address to the business residual loads and additional cleaning cost.
- Report findings to the Global Fleet Manager.
- Oversee depot improvement by performing audits.
- Concludes SLA's and cost agreements with depots.
- Reduce the average depot-through time of a tank container.

Administration

- Efficient and effective administration of all related documents.
- Efficient and effective communication of information to relevant stakeholders.
- Perform work outside the indicated result area as and when deemed necessary by NewPort management.
